## ---- BIG NEWS

Last year, the construction of the world's largest vertical farm, Ynfarm, was completed. Since December 2023, the first deliveries of Frass, an insect-based fertilizer, have been regularly taking place on site. This is a significant milestone for the Farmyng project. Very soon, proteins derived from the processing of larvae will also be produced and delivered from the site. More than ever, we are nearing our goal: addressing the food and climate crises by providing high-quality products for both animals and plants. Thank you and congratulations to all Farmyng partners!

As, Ÿnfarm is currently starting production, Ÿnsect announces a historic milestone: after 2-year authorization, Ϋ́nsect secured the first-ever authorization from the Association of American Feed Control Officials (AAFCO) for the commercialization of defatted mealworm proteins for dog nutrition in the United-States. This authorization is a game-changer and opens new opportunities in the thriving American pet food market.

A new president for B4C! At the beginning of 2024, Michel Mangion was elected as the new president, with a program focused on three pillars: transition, sustainability, and reindustrialization. For the next three years, he aims to continue the ongoing initiatives while strengthening B4C's expertise and impact on sustainability issues, thereby establishing the group as a key player in the transition towards a greener and more responsible economy.


